Daniel Miller and Jason Jacks with Stanley Consultants discussed stormwater at Texas A&M, describing conditions that were putting infrastructure at risk and the associated measures taken to stabilize these areas.

They informed the types of solutions they did such as reduce peak discharges with detention ponds, stabilize channel and banks, and strengthen the structure foundations.

In summary, keep a lookout for issues, use hydraulic engineering methods to protect your structures, and know that all natural channels change.

DID YOU KNOW...?
