Reactor Tour

DID YOU KNOW...?

- The amount of water on Earth is constant, and continually recycled over time: some of the water you drink will have passed through a dinosaur.
- 27,000 trees are felled each day for toilet paper.
- There is no known scientific way of predicting earthquakes. The most reliable method is to count the number of missing cats in the local paper: if it trebles, an earthquake is imminent.
- Paper can be recycled only six times. After that, the fibers are too weak to hold together.



In June, we invited the local Air & Waste Management Association Chapter to join us on a tour of the nuclear reactor at the J.J. Pickle Campus Nuclear Engineering Teaching Laboratory, which is owned and operated by the University of Texas at Austin.

The University operates a 1.1 megawatt nuclear reactor at this site and is used by the Cockrell School of Engineering's Nuclear and Radiation Engineering Program as a teaching and research tool.

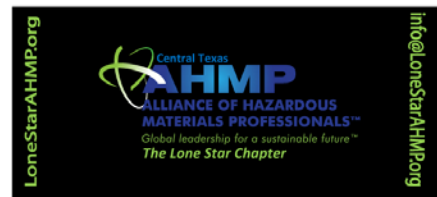


Lone Star Chapter Koozies are in...
